What is "Dujiangyan 都江堰



 The Dujiangyan is an ancient irrigation system in Dujiangyan City, Sichuan, China. Originally constructed around 256 BC by the State of Qin as an irrigation and flood control project, it is still in use today. The system's infrastructure develops on the Min River, the longest tributary of the Yangtze.











 A Chinese irrigation engineer and politician of the <u>Warring States period</u>, renowned for his association with the <u>Dujiangyan Irrigation System</u>, the construction of which he instigated and overseen. Because of the importance of this 2000-yearold <u>irrigation</u> system to the development of <u>Sichuan</u> and the <u>Yangtze River</u> region, Dujiangyan is still in use today and is listed as a <u>UNESCO</u> World Heritage Site.



What is learning control?



Iterative Learning Control (ILC) is a method of tracking control for systems that work in a repetitive mode. Examples of systems that operate in a repetitive manner include robot arm manipulators, chemical batch processes and reliability testing rigs. In each of these tasks the system is required to perform the same action over and over again with high precision. This action is represented by the objective of accurately tracking a chosen reference signal r(t) on a finite time interval.
